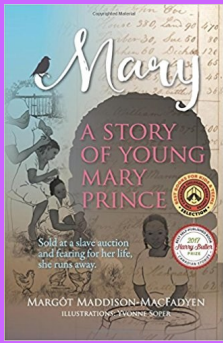

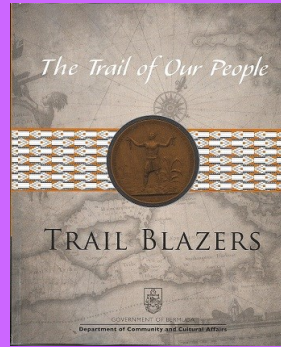

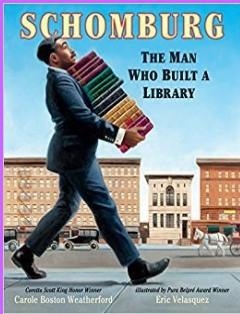
CELEBRATING BLACK HISTORY

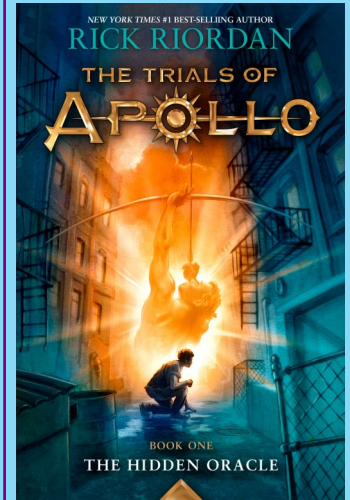

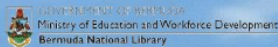
